Librettist: Tchaikovsky, based on Alexander Pushkin's 1831 verse novel of the same name.

World Premiere: March 29, 1879 at the Maly Theater in Moscow

Language: Sung in Russian with projected English translations.

Running time: approximately three hours, including one 25-minute intermission

Production: Company premiere. A joint production of the Finnish National Opera (Helsinki) and the Royal Opera House, Covent Garden (London).
